

The Parking Appeals Board is the 2nd tier of a three tier parking appeal's process.

The first tier is Parking Division. If the office fails to dismiss a ticket, the claimant has the right to submit a request to appeal their citation to the Parking Appeals Board. The board reads the claimant's written statement and allows claimant to make a verbal statement, present pictures and answer any questions the board may have. After this is complete, the board votes and notifies the claimant of their decision.

If the claimant is not satisfied with the Parking Appeals Board's decision, they can request their case be heard by the Higher Authority/Chancellor's designee within 14 days.

The Appeal's Board meets 2-3 times each semester and 1 time during the summer. The following report reflects the summer meeting that was held on July 22, 2013.

There were 17 cases on the list.
