- Student Center Advisory Board has met once (November 1, 2010) since my last report given on February 17, 2010
- FY 12 proposed student fee: \$136.45 (2.98% increase over FY 11 mandate per Chancellor to keep below 3%
- Student Center has reduced expenses in the following ways:
 - o Eliminated one (1) cashier position
 - o Not filled the Coordinator of Student Programming Council (SPC) position
 - Cut back building hours (impacted student employment hours)
- Still negotiating with McDonalds; a new and better contract is close
- Textbook rentals began Fall 2010
 - Positive change for students
 - Some negative impact on Student Center not as much commission from book rentals as book purchases
- Building maintenance update
 - o HVAC project now complete and more efficient
 - o Lighting replacement will begin on 3rd floor
 - o Freight elevator code work to begin
 - o Replacement of chairs in ballroom area
 - o Fire pump work to begin
 - Bookstore renovation
