



## SIGNAGE COMMITTEE REPORT for A/P Council

The committee has only met one time since my last report to A/P Council.

The following issues were discussed at the meeting held in December 2009:

There was a request from the College of Applied Sciences to have an additional directional sign installed. This was approved by the committee but won't be installed until the college can obtain funding to purchase and install it in their desired location.

The Coal Research Center on the Carterville Campus requested a sign installed in front of their Administration Building with four different outside logos. The committee had developed a written policy against the use of 3<sup>rd</sup> party logos on SIU signage. The committee recommended they bring their proposal/photos to the next meeting for further discussion.

The committee is working to develop a policy related to controlling venue-type signage for facilities on campus that sponsor public interaction (i.e. Paul Simon Public Policy Institute, Dental Clinic, Wham Clinical Center, Alumni Association, Evaluation and Developmental Center, etc.)

The new brick entrance signage materials have been ordered for the Chautauqua/Oakland intersection.

The next meeting has not been scheduled at this time.
