Parking Appeals Report  
April 21<sup>th</sup> 2010

The parking appeals board is the second tier of the appeal's process. The first tier is the parking office. If the office fails to grant (i.e. drop the ticket), the violator has the right to submit a request for an appeal for the parking appeals board. The board then reads the written statement and allows the appellant to make a statement and ask any questions. After this is complete, the board votes to grant or deny and notifies the appellant.

The board meets 2 to 3 times each semester. Following is a summary of the of the appeals decisions by violation description for FY 10 to date:
