- John Massie was named interim director early this year after Willie Ehling left late last year.
- The search for a permanent director is under way. The third candidate is on campus today. It shouldn't be too long before a new director is named.
- Probably everyone knows about the plan to take out the Pulliam Pool and Gym and convert that space in an academic area for the School of Art and Design. \$7 million project.
- Kathy Hollister, assistant director for special populations, is retiring.
- Lynn Thompson, assistant director for fitness, left for a new position at the University of Illinois Chicago.

Both positions will be filled.

- In September 2011, the SIU Board of Trustees approved a \$4 million project to improve energy efficiency and to upgrade the Student Rec Center's HVAC systems. Design work is under way....should see work begin next spring...completed by 2015.
- Some concern about revenue. Summer camp attendance is down....SIU lost the Christ in Youth Camp.
- The little store across from the info desk closed at the end of May. 710 Bookstore chose not to continue the operation.
