I am happy to announce, after three years without a permanent director, the UPA Director position was finally filled this month after a successful search. Dr. Michelle Hughes Miller has agreed to accept the position of Director of University Professional Advancement

My term on this committee expired this year. During this time period, the committee met several times, basically to discuss the replacement for the director. There were two prior searches, with the committee meeting several times to interview candidates. However, because of various reasons, both of the previous searches did not result in a candidate being selected.

The committee continues to promote the advancement of women on campus. They are working hard to advancing women into and hiring women for higher level administrative position at SIUC.
