Parking Appeals Report

My term as chair of the parking appeals chair has been completed as of this semester. I would like to thank the council for giving me the opportunity to serve as chairman of the parking appeals board. I found the experience to be insightful and rewarding. I have included a brief statement regarding the role of the board and a summary of the decisions over the last year.

Summary of the role of the parking appeals board.

The parking appeals board is the second tier of the appeals process. The first tier is the parking office. If the office fails to grant (i.e. drop the ticket), the violator has the right to submit a request for an appeal for the parking appeals board. The board then reads the written statement and allows the appellant to make a statement and ask any questions. After this is complete, the board votes to grant or deny and notifies the appellant.

The board meets 2 to 3 times each semester. Following is a summary of the of the appeals decisions by volition description:
