Vote status: all appeals lacked merit, as was unanimous in the Executive Committee, and all sanctions imposed by Student Rights and Responsibilities Office were recommended to be upheld.

Sanctions Imposed:

1. Disciplinary suspension from the University for 1 year (3 cases);
2. Disciplinary suspension from the University for 2 years (1 case)
