Staffing levels are being maintained despite some of the hiring difficulties on campus.

Other

The Clery Act Crime Report for 2011 has been submitted. (see attachment) A Public Safety Compliance Coordinator has been hired who will be responsible for mandatory training including Clery Act, Child Abuse Reporting, Sex Offender Reporting, etc. More than 1200 persons went through the mandatory Clery Act training. Outdoors lights are being converted to LED across campus. Efforts are underway to get new warning sirens on campus.
