Operating Paper Committee A/P Staff Council Final Report 2011-2012

The Operating Paper Committee's FY12 goals included drafting fairly extensive revisions to the current Operating Paper to reflect changes in sector definition, standing committees, and other modifications designed to clarify or update our procedures.

Specifically, amendments to the Operating Paper included:

- 1. Simplification of the definition of membership in the A/P constituency.
- 2. Modification in the definition of sectors to reflect University restructuring and to provide for sector representation in the event of future restructuring.
- 3. Clarification of the Council's action to affirm the nomination of representatives to University committees.
- 4. Reflection of the changes in the campus Faculty and Staff Excellence award program.
- 5. Consolidation of the Staff Benefits and Staff Welfare Committees into a Staff Benefits and Welfare Committee.

The committee members did considerable research with much discussion on the issues of membership definition and sector representation before drafting revisions to the Operating Paper. Those amendments were drafted by the committee, proposed and finally adopted by the Council and the constituency in the spring of 2012.

A/P Staff Council Staff Benefits and Staff Welfare Committees 2011-2012 Final Report May 2012

The Staff Benefits Committee is charged with review of policies and procedures regarding position classifications, salary, performance evaluations, terms and conditions of employment, and other administrative/professional benefits. In addition, the committee is responsible for review and approval of those materials published either in handbooks, or other such compilations affecting the benefits of AP staff for the purpose of providing current and accurate information about and to the constituency.

The Staff Welfare committee shall address issues of affirmative action, professional development, grievance procedure, Judicial Review Board training and other issues affecting the A/P constituency. A member of this committee serves on the Judicial Review Board. The members of this committee review and approve information about A/P staff published in University handbooks and other publications in order to maintain current, accurate information about the constituency.

2011-2012 ACTIONS

The two committees, being similar in the nature regarding the issues that comes before them, were recommended to be combined into one committee, Staff Benefits and Welfare Committee (SBW). The change was brought to the AP constituency for vote spring 2012 and was approved. The Operating Paper of the AP Staff Council now reflects the one committee and it's charge.

Work continues on making changes to the Judicial Review Board Operating Paper to clarify issues and reflect recent changes made to the AP Staff Council Operating Paper. These changes are mainly focused on the composition of the membership due to recent changes in Academic Affairs, Student Affairs, General, and School of Medicine. The upcoming SBW Committee will finalize this issue. This change had to await the spring vote on changes to the AP Staff Council Operating Paper.

The only other issues brought to the attention of this committee were concerns made through committee member A. Jackson by an AP staff member who preferred to remain anonymous. The concerns were regarding the policy on verification of absences due to illness and the policy on appointment of interim positions. The issues were addressed at last meeting of Council on April 18, 2012, and minutes reflect the committee's response.
